

CONFIRMATION POINTS SYSTEM

There are at least four key areas of faith connection that can benefit our youth as they grow as Christians. There is also an understanding that our youth all learn and grow via different means. This points system allows each student to “customize” their learning and growing process. Points are available for the following:

Worship – attend worship and complete a brief summary. If you attend some place other than Holy Trinity, please bring a bulletin from the service and a sermon summary.

Education – attend Sunday School or a small group Bible Study (other than Wednesday evening Confirmation classes) and complete a brief summary for each class session attended. Another option is to read a chapter of the Bible (your choice) and complete a brief summary.

Service – participate in any event that helps someone else at or with the church, or on your own. Two things should be true about your participation: it should be your idea (in other words, someone didn’t have to tell you to do it!), and you should not get paid. Fill out and turn in a summary sheet for each event.

Fellowship – attend a Youth Group event at church (3rd Wednesday, weekend, etc.) and complete a brief summary. If the event is an overnight or weekend, receive one point for each day.

Each “event” that is completed (with a summary form turned in) is worth one point. For any of these events, one “Bonus Point” will be given if you bring a friend!

A total of 40 total points is needed per year (October – May):

Required: 5 points from each of the four categories (5 X 4 = 20 points)

“Electives”: 20 additional points from any one or more of the areas
