Topics for Discussion

Leadership Workshop – Saturday, February 27

Reviewed materials and agenda for the leadership workshop. We anticipate approximately 20 people. Lori Boynton will bring refreshments.

1. Lynnette will lead opening prayer.
2. Paula will lead introductions (as part of step 3 below)
3. Paula will lead people through the leadership structure slideshow
4. Otti will lead a presentation on Volunteer Coordination using slides and showing the Volunteer spreadsheet and examples from the volunteer manual (in development)
5. Paula will talk about relationships between Core Team (liaisons) and Ministry Teams, including communication, handling new ideas, changes in existing goals

8. Pastor Chad will present on the Rule of Christ conflict resolution process
9. Visioning/Goal setting will be introduced by Pastor Chad,
 - a. People will be asked to recall the new vision statement, other initiatives they have witnessed or been involved with, connecting those with the vision statement
 - b. People will be invited to brainstorm “every member” initiatives that will help a) people in our congregation grow spiritually and b) help people outside our church understand what we are about. Participants will select 3-4 of them that will be taken to the congregation. People in the congregation will be asked to choose one or more and reflect throughout the year to discern changes (individually and corporately) that come about because of implementing the “every member initiatives.”
 - c. The whole group will be invited to brainstorm ideas for the church as a whole.
 - d. People will then go into their ministry team + liaison groups and come up with calendar of events for 2016 and come up with one new initiative within their ministry they would like to move toward (in a concrete way) in 2016.

Other:

Include children and youth on Stewardship campaign, maybe with different color cards and options to give \$ or help with selected activities.
