  - Reconciling Ministries (Carol/Chad) On May 1 we will hold a congregational meeting to discuss what Reconciling Ministries are, and Why, How and When we as a congregation will explore this idea. There will be a Q&A time at this meeting, and then further study and other congregational activities happen over the next few months, with a straw poll scheduled to take place in November to see where the congregation feels our church lands. There are different levels of inclusion. Doing nothing, just following the expected UMC actions, the language will likely become more open. To be part of a reconciling network involves making a more public proclamation, and also allows a congregation to act before the General Conference will be able to act (the soonest is 2024.) The Global Methodist Church, which is using the current exclusionary language and adding more penalties for people who violate it, is planning to launch May 1, 2022. There will be many opinions as we begin a deeper conversation on this issue, but we need to remember that we agree with each other in more ways than we disagree, and that we are all beloved children of God, worthy of being listened to carefully.
