Jim Weninger—had an outpatient surgical procedure on Friday. Jim also asks for prayers for Liz.

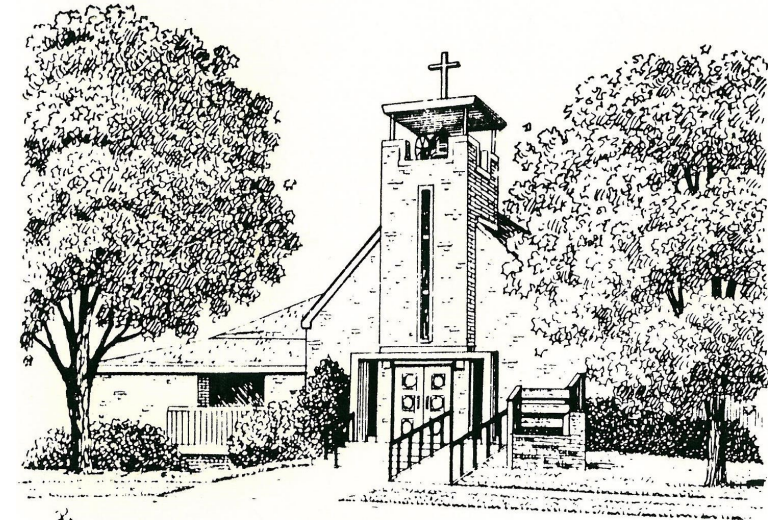
Jim Helgersen and Lori Boynton—prayers for Jim's sister, Candi, who was diagnosed with a brain tumor and had surgery on Friday.
